



NORTHCOTE SOCIAL CLUB CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Northcote Social Club strives to be a safe and inclusive space where all patrons across all walks of life can feel welcome. We aim to create an environment for patrons and staff alike where everybody is treated with dignity, courtesy and respect.

We ask all patrons to abide by the following conditions of entry:

Responsible Service of Alcohol legislation applies to all ticket holders. The venue reserves the right to refuse entry to the band room should a ticket holder be deemed intoxicated or are behaving in an aggressive or antisocial way. The right of admission is reserved and is subject to this code of conduct, liquor licensing laws and the terms and conditions agreed to at time of purchase irrespective of that person being in possession of a valid ticket.

Valid ID must be shown upon entry to the band room even if you have a pre purchased ticket and patrons agree to have their bags checked upon entry to the venue.

The venue is operating within the Hospitality Industry Guidelines as set out by the DHHS and in line with our Covid Safe Plan.

The venue reserves the right to refuse entry to people who do not comply with the venues Covid Safe standards, by refusing to provide contact details, maintain physical distancing or behaving safely.

We require a fitted face mask to be worn in the venue.

These can be removed when seated for food and drink.

Masks must be worn when moving around the venue to service areas, common areas and bathrooms.

Entry to the bandroom is not permitted to persons under 18 years of age unless the event is specified as an 'Underage Event'.

Any form of harassment or aggressive behaviour will result in your removal from the venue. If you experience any form of anti-social behaviour in our venue, please don't hesitate to speak to a member of staff.

For the safety of all patrons crowd surfing, stage diving or any other form of dangerous and high risk behaviour is not permitted or encouraged.

For your safety please ensure footwear is worn at all times.

You agree not to record or transmit, or aid in recording or transmitting, any

description, account, picture, or reproduction of the event without the express permission of the artist. The performance remains the property of the artist.

Professional audio and video recording equipment is not permitted without the express permission of the artist.

You consent to being filmed by our CCTV systems and by artists who record their shows.

Please be aware that while the venue strives to maintain a safe and inclusive space, some of the artists appearing may use lyrics, language, gestures or symbols that some people may find offensive. Please also take into account that this an artistic performance and does not reflect the values of Northcote Social Club and its staff however please do not hesitate to speak to a member of staff if you feel uncomfortable.

Any form of tagging or graffiti will not be tolerated and offending patrons will be removed from the venue.
