

NORTHCOTE SOCIAL CLUB CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Northcote Social Club strives to be a safe and inclusive space where all patrons can feel welcome.

The right of admission is reserved and is subject to this code of conduct, liquor licensing laws and the terms and conditions agreed to at time of purchase irrespective of that person being in possession of a valid ticket for an event.

Responsible Service of Alcohol legislation applies to all patrons and ticket holders.

Government Health Orders apply to all patrons, contractors and staff.

Harassment or aggressive behaviour will result in your removal from the venue.

Crowd surfing, stage diving or any other form of dangerous and high risk behaviour is not permitted or encouraged, and will result in your removal from the venue.

Entry to the venue is not permitted to persons under 18 years of age unless in the company of a responsible adult.

Entry to the band room is not permitted to persons under 18 unless the event is advertised as 'Under 18' in line with special conditions of the license.

Valid ID must be shown upon entry to the venue even if you have a pre-purchased ticket.

You may have your bag checked on entry, prohibited items include but are not limited to; weapons, alcohol, spray paint

Footwear must be worn at all times.

You agree not to record or transmit, or aid in recording or transmitting, any description, account, picture, or reproduction of the event without the express permission of the artist. The performance remains the property of the artist.

You consent to being filmed by our CCTV systems in line with licensing requirements. You consent to being filmed or have your picture taken for the purposes of marketing, and publicity by the venue or artists.

15% Surcharge will be applied to food and drink purchases on Public Holidays, the venue reserves the right to alter prices.

Tagging or graffiti will not be tolerated and will result in your removal from the venue.

Artists appearing at the venue may use lyrics, language, gestures or symbols that some people may find offensive. Artistic performances do not always reflect the values of Northcote Social Club and its staff, speak to a member of staff if you feel uncomfortable.
